

Remote Online Notarization vs Mobile Notary: Which Is Better For Your Documents?

The notarization landscape has changed. Now, you have two excellent paths: Remote Online Notarization (RON) or traditional mobile notary services. Which one is right for you?

Remote Online Notarization (RON)

RON allows you to get documents notarized via a secure video call.

- Pros: 24/7 availability, lower cost (\$25 starting), no travel needed, digital audit trail.
- Identity Check: Uses Knowledge-Based Authentication (KBA). You must answer 4/5 questions correctly (2 attempts allowed, 24-hour lockout if you fail).

Mobile Notary

A mobile notary travels to your location in Tacoma.

- Pros: Personal interaction, ideal for physical witnesses, no tech skills required, perfect for complex signings.

When to Choose Mobile?

Choose mobile when you need physical witnesses, prefer face-to-face guidance, or have signers who aren't tech-savvy.

When to Choose RON?

Choose RON when you're short on time, signers are in different locations, or you want a budget-friendly option.

Tips for RON success:

- Use Google Chrome.
- Use a PC or laptop instead of a phone.
- Have your ID ready.
